

- SHIFT (n) a change in position, direction, and/or tendency. Switch, alteration, rearrangement.
  - For true follower of Christ, the goal and intention is to deny ourselves and our human nature with a view to subject of ourselves to God's transformational process, where we give God room to take us, shake us, and make us into whatever it is He designed us to be in accordance with His purpose for our lives.

- SHIFT (n) a change in position, direction, and/or tendency. Switch, alteration, rearrangement.
  - Shift affords for a deviation from that which is constant, to another degree of existence.
  - To that end, the life of a disciple is one of constant shifting and shaping, construction, framing and carving, measuring and cutting, sketching and sculpting, because we're never at a point of completion and our lives will perpetually experience shifts to match the design of the Divine.

#### Jeremiah 18:1-6

- There's a lump of clay (shapeless, lifeless, deformed, nebulous/vague, indistinct, deformed, disfigured, undeveloped, imperfect, flawed
  - Nothing wrong with being a lump of clay, (it's in the Potters House!)
  - We're here because we're consenting and confirming a desire to be worked on
  - God, put your hands on me.
- Power of Potter, Prodecure of the Potter,
   Patience of the Potter
- Leads to a Perfected Pot
